

**The following information may be useful to those wishing to make a bequest to the Footwear Benevolent Society (Footwear Friends)**

**FOR A RESIDUARY BEQUEST**

“I give the residue of my estate to the Footwear Benevolent Society (Footwear Friends) of 5, Portland Place, London W1B 1PW for its charitable purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer of the Footwear Benevolent Society (Footwear Friends) for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.”

**FOR A SPECIFIC BEQUEST**

“I give the sum of £ ..... (or the item specified) to the Footwear Benevolent Society (Footwear Friends) of 5, Portland Place, London W1B 1PW for its charitable purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer of the Footwear Benevolent Society (Footwear Friends) for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.”

**CODICILS**

You should consult your Solicitor over the precise wording that is appropriate for your Codicil, but here is an example of the wording of a typical Codicil:

“I (full name) of (address) DECLARE this to be a First Codicil to my Will dated (date in words).

1. I GIVE the sum of (amount in words and figures) to the Footwear Benevolent Society (Footwear Friends) of 5, Portland Place, London W1B 1PW for its charitable purposes. I further direct that the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or any other proper officer of the Footwear Benevolent Society for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.
2. IN ALL other respects I confirm my said Will.

IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this (date in words).

SIGNED by the said (name) the Testator as and for the First Codicil to his (her) said Will dated the (date) in the presence of us both being present at the same time who at his (her) request presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names and witnesses:
